### **Details of member's evenings**

#### **14<sup>th</sup> September (Summer Challenge)**

Bring along 1 image on each of the challenge topics, Abandoned, Fast Shutter, Leading Lines, Silhouette & Reflection and provide a brief talk on your work

#### **28<sup>th</sup> September (Creating Effective, PDIs and print entries)**

This will encompass how to present your images correctly for PDI and print competitions, cataloguing your images and tracking your progress through the year.

#### **19<sup>th</sup> October (Creative editing )**

An opportunity to learn some new post processing techniques. The topics will be based on the OPS member survey but please feel free to suggest other areas and be prepared to show your skills.
